ASU academic session begins at Mangaldai

MANGALDAI, Jan 19: The Assam Skill University (ASU) here on Monday witnessed the launch of its much awaited academic functioning with the commencement of the second semester classes for nine different trades, though construction works are still in progress. This marked a significant milestone for skill-based higher education in Assam and the Northeast.

A total of 270 students from the second semester across nine specialized courses which

included masters, undergraduate, and diploma curriculums attended the first day of classes. Earlier, the first semester classes were held at its temporary campus at Rehabari, Guwahati since July, 2025.

The day was attended by key university officials, including vice chancellor Subhas Chandra Das, IAS (retd.), deputy registrar Dr Jagadish Nath, controller of examinations Dr Bhaba Ranjan Sarma, dean academics and School of Technology Prof Manoj Kr Deka, and dean School of Tourism, Hospitality and Wellness

Prof Mahesh Uniyal. It may be mentioned here that ASU, established under the Assam Skill University Act, 2020, is funded primarily through an external aid project by the Asian Development Bank (ADB), with a loan of approximately 112 million dollars. The funding follows an 80:20 ratio, with 20 per cent of fund contributed by the Government of Assam. The foundation stone of the university was laid by then Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal on February 15, 2021, and the 'bhumi puja' was performed

by Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma on November 6, 2022.

Apart from short-term training and diplomas, the university will offer advanced diplomas, bachelor of vocational (BVoc), master of vocational (MVoc), and research-level vocational degrees. It is poised to build capacity in the technical and vocational education and training (TVET) sector across the Eastern region, empowering youth to realize their potential while creating skilled manpower for the State's and nation's development.

Union Minister reviews development works in Goalpara

GOALPARA, Jan 19: Union Minister of State for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship and Education, Jayant Chaudhary, visited Goalpara today to attend and review a series of programmes focused on skill development, entrepreneurship, and overall socio-economic growth in the district.

During his visit, the Union Minister first inspected the integrated farm located within the premises of the District Industries and Commerce Centre. District commissioner of Goalpara, Prodig Timung, was present during the inspection. The Minister reviewed the scientific methods adopted at the farm for rearing ducks, poultry, goats, various breeds of domesticated birds, and ornamental fish. Expressing satisfaction over the initiatives, Chaudhary remarked that such scientific and integrated farming practices have immense potential for income generation, and should be expanded further to strengthen rural livelihoods and promote self-employment.

Thereafter, the Union Minister visited the Industrial Training Institute (ITI) under the Skill, Employment and Entrepreneurship department of Goalpara district. He interacted with departmental officials and trainees, and took stock of the overall functioning of the institute. Special discussions were held on the Tata Technologies training unit, where trainees are being imparted hands-on training in advanced technologies, including electronics, modern manufacturing processes, and various components of electric vehicles. Emphasising the importance of the Skill India Mission, Chaudhary stated that such indus-

try-linked training centres play a crucial role in making the youth job-ready and aligning their skills with emerging market demands. He highlighted that Goalpara is steadily benefiting from Skill India initiatives through improved training infrastructure, industry partnerships, and enhanced employment opportunities for local youth.

Later, Jayant Chaudhary attended a review meeting on the Aspirational District programme at the conference hall of the district commissioner's office, which was attended by Prodig Timung along with other senior officials of the district administration.

Goalpara district has been identified as an Aspirational District by the NITI Aayog. Focused efforts are being undertaken in key sectors such as education, agriculture, health and nutrition, social justice, and infrastructure development in the district.

The Union Minister also reviewed the progress of the ongoing works under the Aspirational District programme. He expressed satisfaction over the developmental initiatives being carried out in the district and advised the administration to accelerate the pace of development to achieve greater outcomes. He emphasised the Prime Minister's sustained focus on the Northeastern region through policy initiatives and frequent visits, highlighting concerted efforts to boost skill development, economic growth, and inclusive development. The Minister noted that his visit reflects the Government of India's commitment to strengthening infrastructure, expanding employment opportunities, and ensuring deeper integration of the Northeast with the national growth story.

Students' body demands anti-erosion measures between Maijan, Bogibeel

DIBRUGARH, Jan 19: Local students under the banner of All Dibrugarh Students' Union (ADSU) today staged a 12-hour hunger strike at Phoolbagan, demanding immediate and comprehensive anti-erosion measures along the highly vulnerable stretch of the Brahmaputra river between Maijan and Bogibeel.

The protest, which began at 6 am, was organized to draw attention to what the students' body described as an 'alarming negligence' of the Water Resources department in addressing the recurring threat of erosion, and flooding in and around Dibrugarh town. Protesters alleged that anti-erosion works in the critical stretch were being carried out in a half-hearted and sluggish manner, despite the area's long history of flood caused by the river.

Speaking to the media, ADSU president Tanuj Haloi said the city is under threat from the Brahmaputra, as visible erosion-control activities have come to a standstill over the past week. "There is no sense of urgency on the ground. The pace of work is extremely slow, which makes us believe that the contractors engaged by the Water Resources department are treating the issue lightly. We demand the immediate intervention of the Chief Minister and senior officials of the department to ensure the works are taken up on a war footing," Haloi said.

He further stressed that temporary measures such as the use of geobags had repeatedly failed to provide lasting protection. According to ADSU, only a permanent and scientifically designed solution could safeguard the city from future erosion.

ADSU general secretary Papu Saikia echoed similar concerns, pointing out that the dry season offered the most suitable window for executing major anti-erosion works. "This is the time when comprehensive measures should have been implemented with full intensity. Unfortunately, despite our repeated appeals, the threat of erosion continues to loom large over historic Dibrugarh," he said. Criticising what he described as symbolic responses from elected representatives, Saikia alleged that inspections during the monsoon season often ended with assurances rather than concrete action. "Whenever erosion intensifies during the rains, local MLA rushes to the site and gives assurances, claiming that Dibrugarh is safe. But the people living along the Brahmaputra know the reality. They continue to live in fear and insecurity," he added.
